First stop is Blenheim Palace: the birth place of Sir Winston Churchill and afterwards you will discover the history and culture of the university city of Oxford.

The history of Oxford in England dates back to its original settlement in the Saxon period. Originally of strategic significance due to its controlling location on the upper reaches of the River Thames at its junction with the River Cherwell, the town grew in national importance during the early Norman period, and in the late 12th century became home to the fledgling University of Oxford.

Blenheim Palace is home to the 12th Duke and Duchess of Marlborough. A true masterpiece of 18th Century Baroque architecture, Blenheim Palace delivers an awe-inspiring experience for visitors. The Pleasure Gardens has a dedicated family area that offers a giant hedge maze, butterfly house and adventure playground.
